Musical Theater Workshop

The magic of musical theater doesn't only happen when the curtain goes up. In this workshop, kids experience everything involved in creating and performing in a show, from casting to final production. In these musicals, just as in a professional show, only one child is cast in the lead role. All other participants join an ensemble and everyone will have the opportunity to try out for roles the first three weeks of the semester. Regardless of role, every student experiences the teamwork and camaraderie involved in putting on a show through production-based weekly rehearsals, gaining valuable skills in collaboration, problem solving, and communication, as they build self-esteem in a warm and supportive environment. The workshop culminates in a performance of the fully produced musical for family and friends, with every child performing, and showcasing every student's creative journey.

Musical Theater Revue

Kids who love being on stage experience the magic of musical theater as they rehearse toward an end-of-year performance for family and friends of *Disney's Dare to Dream Jr*. This fun and relaxed new weekly class has no audition requirement – every child who wants a part gets a part, and everyone has the chance to shine. Your child decides how much they want to participate, and with small class sizes, every student gets personal attention and support. Whether your child loves to sing, dance, act, or all three, they'll develop their creativity, build confidence, and learn teamwork skills as they rehearse favorite Disney songs and dance numbers, then bring it all to life in a fabulous show!

Musical Theater Conservatory

This new pre-professional program is for serious musical theater students preparing for auditions at the college level or at specialized arts high schools and middle schools, and those committed to pursuing musical theater at a high level. Students will intensify their training in weekly classes taught by expert faculty, with 40 minutes of instruction in each musical theater dance (Broadway Tap Performance and Broadway Jazz Performance), vocal performance, and acting.* Students receive personalized coaching and expert guidance to hone their craft and take their talent to the next level. Expert faculty will be supported by a rotation of guest artists sharing professional experience and insights, together giving students authoritative training to help them pursue their artistic dreams.

Musical Theater Teen Production

Teens and near-teens ready for a dedicated pre-professional theater experience will thrive, learn, and grow in this by-audition-only, process-based weekly workshop where they'll experience every step involved in creating and performing in a musical. Every student is cast in an ensemble role, with pre-workshop auditions required for all (see audition information below). Together students collaborate on producing a work from the musical theater canon, practicing teamwork and problem-solving skills while building confidence and exploring their creativity as individuals. The workshop culminates in a fully produced show for family and friends, with every student's talent and contributions showcased.

Audition Information

For our 11+ production of *Hadestown Teen Edition* all roles will be cast through our video auditions.

Students must submit an audition prior to registering.

To audition, please submit a video* of your performer singing 16 bars (30 seconds) of a musical theater song of their choice. At the beginning of the video, please have your performer clearly state the following information:

- Name
- Age
- The role they would like to audition for

Completed audition videos must be submitted to <u>this Dropbox folder</u>. If your child is not currently registered in our program, please send an email to <u>MT@92ny.org</u> with your child's name and preferred contact information, after submitting their audition.

Casting will begin August 20, 2025.
